Recitation: The point of this class is to assist the students by going over problems and any other concepts the professor does not have time to go over in class. This class aims to help give a better understanding of chemistry and its principles in a smaller classroom setting.

I will go over problems in class that I have designed to help you. However, since this class is for you please feel free to bring to class or email any problems or concepts that you would like to have explained.

Grading: There will be a total of 100 points in recitation which will make up 17% of the total class grade.

Quizzes: There will be 8 quizzes, each worth 10 pts. These quizzes will be announced a week ahead of time. 7 will count towards your grade, the lowest quiz will be dropped and there will be no make up quizzes. I will also give (2) extra credit quizzes that will not be announced, these quizzes will be worth 5 pts.

Homework: The other 30 points will be covered by (6) 5 pt homework assignments. Homework will consist of 10 problems. Turning the assignment in is worth 2 pts. One random problem will be chosen and graded on

each homework assignment for the other 3 pts. Homework will be due in recitation the Monday after the assignment is given.

Answers to both quizzes and homework will be posted after 5pm on the day they are turned in. I will attempt to have everything graded by the next class.

Attendance: You are encouraged to attend every class on time and be prepared. With no attendance points given and quizzes and homework being announced I will not force you to come. I am here to help you so your attendance is your responsibility.
